- 1. Express themselves and the challenges they face concerning their siblings' diagnosis
- 2. Learn about what ASD is and what it is not
- 3. Develop self-advocacy skills
- 4. Identify values and develop boundary-setting skills to promote healthy sibling interactions.
- 5. Develop an understanding of ABA therapy and how it supports their sibling
- 6. Identify and learn to utilize basic behavioral strategies to promote healthy sibling interactions
